Also, use the above license number to notify the False Alarm Reduction Unit of any modifications/changes that may occur from the registration information you sent in. This license is required by Louisville-Jefferson County Metro Codified Ordinance, Chapter 127.07. Please remember you must remain in compliance of Chapter 127.08 to retain your license.

Please remember that you must provide a current list of all clients that live in Louisville/Jefferson County, Kentucky and are in the Louisville Metro Police jurisdiction. In accordance to LMCO Chapter 127.02. Client list and/or updates shall be forwarded to the Alarm Coordinator before an alarm system monitored by an alarm business is activated.

127.08 - Alarm Business (Partial list of requirements)

(a) Prior to engaging in the activities of or advertising or holding itself out as an alarm business, an alarm business shall obtain a license from the False Alarm Administrator as provided in this ordinance.

The license number shall appear in all advertising and on all vehicles displaying the name of the alarm business while working in Louisville/Jefferson County, KY.

Example: LMPD LIC 123

(b) The license required by this section shall be in addition to any other license and/or permits required by Louisville-Jefferson County Metro Government or the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Once paid your Alarm Company License will be good for 365 days from renewal. Renewal notices will be **EMAILED FROM mpdfalsealarms@louisvilleky.gov** 30 days prior to expiration. Please make sure to keep your contact information up to date.
